Applications are now open for the extended Ontario Support for Learner's program. The program was originally announced in November 2020 but only applied to children up to the age of 12 or children with special needs up to the age of 21 — now, the program has been expanded to include all students up to Grade 12.

Amount

Eligible applicants will receive a one-time payment of:

- \$200 for each child or youth up to Grade 12
- \$250 for each child or youth up to age 21 with special needs

Eligibility

You are eligible to apply if you live in Ontario and are a:

- parent or guardian to a child or youth up to Grade 12
- secondary school student over the age of 18
- parent or guardian to a child or youth that is 21 or younger and has special needs

<u>Please note</u>: Eligibility is not based on income and should be available to most individuals with children in elementary school or high school.

The deadline to apply is February 8, 2021.
